

#### Itinerary:

May 30: Board your ship, enjoy lunch, settle into your stateroom and explore your floating hotel!

May 31: Day at sea.

<u>June 1</u>: **Ketchikan** - You'll love this scenic town, rich in Native heritage and home to the world's oldest collection of Totem Poles. It's also a great fishing location.

<u>June 2</u>: <u>Juneau</u> – Explore more gold mining history along with breathtaking mountain and water scenery. You'll find tons of optional excursions at this port.

<u>June 3</u>: Skagway - Skagway was the gateway to the gold fields for the thousands who flocked to Alaska to "strike it rich". Enjoy this beautiful inlet port, surrounded by majestic mountains. The scenic White Pass and Yukon Railroad is a favorite option.

<u>June 4 - 5</u>: Scenic cruising on pristine Glacier Bay - Princess is one of the select cruiselines permitted to cruise this breathtaking National Park. Continue cruising past College Fjord.

<u>June 6</u>: Step off your ship into a waiting railcar for our exclusive Direct-to-the-Wilderness rail service to the Mt. McKinley Princess Wilderness Lodge for a 1-night retreat. Here you'll settle in with Denali never far from view. Sit and gaze at the majesty of "The Great One" from the lodge's treehouse designed and built by Pete Nelson of Animal Planet's Treehouse Masters. You can choose optional excursions or simply enjoy the grounds of your lovely lodge.

<u>June 7</u>: You have time this morning for an optional excursion. Then depart on a scenic motorcoach ride to the Denali Princess Wilderness Lodge at the doorstep of Denali National Park. Here you may enjoy the spectacular main lodge, river view deck, and Princess Village with the popular Christmas cottage and sugar shack. Be sure to check out Fannie Q's Saloon, named after a famed local homesteader, or sit outside at a fireside patio.

<u>June 8</u>: Start your morning with a quick stop at Fannie Q's saloon for a hearty buffet breakfast. Explore Denali National Park on a Natural History Tour, watching for glimpses of Denali as well as Denali's "Big Five"; moose, caribou, bears, wolves and Dall sheep. Later today, you may want to simply relax on the deck overlooking the Nenana River.

<u>June 9</u>: You'll have the morning to relax, then travel by motorcoach to Fairbanks. This afternoon, take a sternwheeler Riverboat Cruise down the Chena River. You'll get to experience Gold Rush history, Native culture and the colorful Alaska lifestyle of bush pilots, dog sledders, and Native artisans.

June 10: Disembark in Fairbanks and transfer to the airport for your return flight home- or ask us about extending your time in the beautiful town of Fairbanks.
