Friday, October 2, 2026: Depart USA from your preferred city. Arrive in Madrid on October 3, 2026.

<u>Day 1:Saturday, October 3, 2026:</u> <u>Welcome to Madrid.</u> Transfer to hotel, settle in and meet your Tour Director and travel companions for a delicious <u>Welcome Dinner.</u>

<u>Day 2: Sunday, October 4, 2026:</u> <u>Madrid.</u> Guided sightseeing includes the Prado Museum, sights of the Cibeles Fountain and Calle Alcala. The Prado is home to one of the world's largest art collections, including displays of renowned European Masters Rubens and Rembrandt. **Breakfast.**

Day 3: Monday, October 5, 2026: Madrid-Cordoba-Seville. Depart Madrid and travel to Cordoba for a guided walking tour of the Mosque of the Caliphs. The Mosque is now a Catholic Cathedral but was originally built for Muslim prayer in the 8th century. Over 800 granite and marble pillars support brick and stone arches and a soaring bell tower make it the tallest structure in the city. Enjoy some free time to browse before departing for Seville. Breakfast & Dinner.

<u>Day 4: Tuesday, October 6, 2026:</u> <u>Seville.</u> Guided sightseeing includes Casa de Pilatos and a walk through the Santa Cruz quarter with it's magical maze of tapas, flamenco and cafes. The Plaza de Espana was originally built for Seville's Ibero-American Expo at the 1929 World's Fair. The 540,000-sq foot plaza features a sprawling mosaic patio. **Breakfast.**

<u>Day 5: Wednesday, October 7, 2026:</u> <u>Seville-Grenada</u>. Depart Seville and travel to Granada for a guided walking tour including the Alhambra Complex and Water Gardens of the Generalife. This complex is an architectural gem and one of the largest ancient aristocratic sites of Western Muslim culture. It's leafy lanes and streams enhance the water gardens-beautiful! (Entrance to Nasrid Palace not guaranteed)

Breakfast.



<u>Day 6:Thursday, October 8, 2026:</u> Grenada-Valencia. Depart Granada and travel to Valencia for a guided walking tour and a stop for a traditional Horchata tasting. (Drink made from tiger nuts). Later enjoy another tradition; a Paella dinner at a local restaurant. Traditional Spanish Paella Valenciana is made with chicken, sweet paprika and golden saffron in a slow simmered broth. Breakfast and Dinner.

<u>Day 7: Friday, October 9, 2026:</u> <u>Valencia-Barcelona.</u> Enjoy a scenic drive along the coast enroute to Barcelona, a port city set on the shores of the beautiful Mediterranean. Enjoy free time this afternoon and evening. Maybe a stroll along tree-lined La Rambla filled with street performers, artists and sidewalk cafes. Explore the old city and trace the footsteps of Picasso or visit the Gothic Quarter with its narrow, winding streets and hidden courtyards, searching for unique architecture by Antonio Gaudi. **Breakfast**

<u>Day 8: Saturday, October 10, 2026:</u> <u>Barcelona.</u> Guided sightseeing today includes the Columbus Monument, Plaza de Cataluña and panorama views of the city and harbor from Muntjac Hill. A highlight today is a visit to the magnificent Sagrada Familia Basilica. Construction began in 1882 and is expected to be completed in 2026, marking 144 years of construction.

Tonight enjoy Sangria and a farewell dinner at a local city-center restaurant. Breakfast and Dinner.

<u>Day 9: Sunday, October 11, 2026:</u> Transfer to airport for flight home or extend your time to explore more and relax in Barcelona. **Breakfast.**
